Sensitization to cat is strongly associated with asthma, especially in environments free of mite and cockroach (1). The presence of domestic pets increases the prevalence of respiratory symptoms in asthmatic children (2), and children sensitized to cat allergen are more likely to develop a more severe asthma than children with negative tests to cat
